

Juniper Ridge, Jumbo Peak

There are several ways to reach the trailheads; see map for best route depending on where you're coming from. From Randle:

Rd. 2904 trailhead (Juniper Ridge) – turn south at the light in Randle (Hwy 131/Roads 23/25), and then veer left after about 1 mile onto Road 23. Stay on this for about 8 more miles, reaching the turnoff for Road 28. Turn right onto Rd. 28 and go about a mile, passing the Yellowjacket Pond picnic area. Just past this point, look for a gravel road going straight up on the left. Turn onto this, Road 29. Stay on Rd. 29 for about 4 miles, then go left onto Rd. 2904. Proceed on 2904 for about 4 miles to a small saddle, which is the trailhead for both Tongue Mountain and Juniper Ridge.

Rd. 2324.063 trailhead (Sunrise Peak) – Proceed on Rd. 23 from Randle as described above. After passing by Rd. 21, and about 23 miles from Randle, look for Rd. 2324 on the right. Follow 2324 for about 5 miles. Turn left on .063 and follow a short distance to the trailhead. SUV-type vehicles a good choice for either 2904 or 2324.
