Table Mountain

From Vancouver, I-205

Proceed on Hwy. 14 heading east.

Pass by Camas and Washougal. About 21 miles east of Washougal, look for the town of North Bonneville on the right (Chevron station). Continue east on Hwy. 14 for about 2 miles. As you pass by Bonneville dam, look for the Bonneville Trailhead on the left, directly across Hwy. 14 from the gated dam access point (old dam entrance).

From the Gorge areas

Proceed on Hwy. 14 heading west. About 2 miles west of the Bridge of the Gods, look for the Bonneville Trailhead on the right, directly across from the gated dam access point.

Northwest Forest Pass required at Bonneville Trailhead.

Note: The popular trailhead at Bonneville Hot Springs Resort terminated in 2017. However, a possible alternate trailhead (which results in about an 8 mile hike instead of 15+), is to park along the Greenleaf Slough and proceed to the PCT and Table Mountain via Carpenters Lake. This option is only recommended if not crossing private property. See map below.
